

VISITORS WITH SKI EQUIPMENT & DAY SKIING GUESTS

VALLEY-WIDE PUBLIC BUS

Recommended bus stop: Hochgurglbahn Talstation. You can take Hochgurglbahn up to the ski area, then continue on skis/ snowboard along slope no. 41 directly to the finish area of the Ski World Cup. Click here for bus timetable 🔀

PARKING AT HOCHGURGLBAHN BASE STATION

Limited parking is available exclusively for visitors with ski equipment at the base station of Hochgurglbahn gondola on the race days. You can take Hochgurglbahn up to the ski area, then continue on skis/snowboard along slope no. 41 directly to the finish area of the Ski World Cup.

PARKING AT ZWIESELSTEIN EVENT CAR PARK

If capacity at the base station of Hochgurglbahn is exhausted, please leave your car at the event car park in Zwieselstein. From there you can take the comfortable event shuttle to Gurgl, which runs regularly from approx. **08:30**. The use of the shuttle is free of charge. Stop: Hochgurglbahn. You can take Hochgurglbahn up to the ski area, then continue on skis/snowboard along slope no. 41 directly to the finish area of the Ski World Cup.

PARKING AT ZWIESELSTEIN EVENT CAR PARK

If the capacity at the Hochgurglbahn valley station is exhausted, please use the **event car park** in Zwieselstein. From there, an event shuttle will take you comfortably to Gurgl, running from around **08:30** onwards as required. Use of the shuttle is free of charge. Bus stop: Hochgurglbahn valley station. The Hochgurglbahn takes you directly to the ski area. From there Große Karbahn takes you to slope no. 41, which takes you directly to the finish area of the Ski World Cup on ski/snowboard.

GUESTS STAYING OVERNIGHT IN GURGL

GURGL SHUTTLE

For transport from the Hochgurglbahn valley station, you must take the Hochgurglbahn I to the middle station in Hochgurgl. The event area*.

PREMIUM DESTINATION

TOP QUALITY SKIING AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL

Thanks to its high alpine altitude of up to 3,030 h above sea level and 112 kilometers of perfectly groomed ski slopes, Gurgl's prime ski area offers absolute snow guarantee from November through April. At the Diamond of the Alps guests can look forward to exclusive winter enjoyment on and off the beaten slopes. This is also ensured by upscale hotels and restaurants as well as short distances thanks to ski-in & ski-out.

Traditionally, Gurgl is the first non-glacier ski resort to open the winter season: thanks to its high alpine altitude between 1,800 and 3,030 fm, perfect snow conditions for both skiers and snowboarders are guaranteed from November to April. Boasting 25 top modern mountain lifts and 112 slope kilometers of various difficulty levels, winter guests can enjoy one of the highest quality and most snow-sure ski areas in the Alps. Another benefit: the high-performance mountain gondolas and lifts take winter sports enthusiasts quickly and conveniently to the varied ski mountains. The proximity of accommodations to the central mountain lifts promises comfortable "ski in & ski out" with short distances and maximum fun on the slopes, as 90% of the hotels and accommodations are less than 250 fm from the nearest ski slope.

WINTER IN ALL FACETS

Gurgl also has a lot to offer during breaks from the slopes: the impressive Hohe Mut Alm (2,670 m) serves regional delicacies including panoramic views of the surrounding three thousand meter high summits. In terms of architecture, the unique Top Mountain Star 360° panorama bar on Wurmkogel (3,030 fm) offers fabulous views as far as the Dolomites. While the huge Motorcycle Experience World inside the building of Top Mountain Crosspoint, shows over 550 exhibits. For activities and adventures away from the slopes, there are myriad winter hiking trails and untouched winter landscapes just perfect for snowshoe tours. Other highlights: the 3 kilometer long toboggan run which is floodlit in the evening, or the weekly night skiing event.

GURGL CARAT: PRIME EVENT AND CONFERENCE VENUE

A popular meeting place right at the heart of Obergurgl is the state-of-the-art Gurgl Carat congress and event center offering space for up to 520 people. The quiet surroundings are particularly attractive, inviting guests to relax and wind down or enjoy team-building activities as side events. In addition to corporate events and conferences for an international audience, the infrastructure also offers space for art and culture: for example, the Christmas Market on the forecourt or changing exhibitions by renowned artists.



SLALOM DOUBLE PACK

GURGL'S PREMIERE OF TWO WORLD CUP RACES



After the highly successful World Cup debut of the men's slalom last year, the Diamond of the Alps will also host a women's slalom for the first time this year. The organizers have already received an award for being an eco-friendly event and for their sustainable event concept. In 2024, this aspect will be further expanded with optimized comfort for both visitors and athletes.

In November 2024, the world's alpine skiing elite will tackle the demanding Kirchenkar slope already for the second time. This year, slaloms are held for women and men. Such an expansion of last year's event underlines Gurgl's standing as a perfect location for major sports events. Additionally, the Gurgl Ski World Cup is a partner of Green Events Austria and sets best practice examples. The sustainable measures and concepts will be further expanded in 2024.

SUSTAINABILITY AS A GUIDING PRINCIPLE

In line with the Green Event certification, there is also a strong focus on environmentally friendly measures this year. "The shared use of already existing infrastructure and short transport routes within Ötztal underline our efforts to achieve more regionality and sustainability in skiing sports," emphasizes Alban Scheiber, chairman of the organizing committee. In 2024, emission-free electric vehicles will be used to transport media representatives from Obergurgl to Hochgurgl. In addition, mainly regional foodstuffs from local producers will be used while reusable containers and cups are provided. The 2023 slalom races in Gurgl were recognized as one of Austria's most eco-friendly events in the "sporting events" category.

ONE WEEKEND, TWO SLALOM COMPETITIONS

The race weekend in Gurgl will bring several logistical challenges, but also great synergy effects. The shared infrastructure for both races - from grandstands to the race track – guarantees a highly efficient and resource-saving organization. The slalom race course remains unchanged on both days in order to minimize the environmental impact. Only the exact race course layout of the women's and men's competitions will differ minimally. The number of helpers for such a smooth running of two race events amounts to 600 people by guaranteeing the usual high standard and offering a really memorable experience to all ski fans.

IMPROVED COMFORT FOR FANS AND GUESTS

In addition to sporting highlights, the focus is on comfort for visitors and guests. An extended transport concept with shuttles to Top Mountain Crosspoint makes getting there much easier. Spectator capacity in the finish area has also been optimized: the new grandstand offers around 1,300 fans the best view of all races while additional refreshment stands ensure a varied culinary choice and quick service. HIGH ALPINE SUMMER WELLNESS

GURGL – SUMMER ENJOYMENT AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL



During the warm season, the Diamond of the Alps unfolds a multitude of adventures and relaxation options – ranging from trendy forest bathing to alpine activities such as hiking and e-biking to exciting adventures on the via ferrata. Even prominent athletes, such as professional cyclist Toni Palzer, appreciate the high alpine altitude and pleasant temperatures for their training camps. The panoramic Timmelsjoch High Alpine Road connecting North and South Tyrol, offers a very special challenge. For all those who want to take it easy, the route is a picturesque excursion destination – best combined with a visit to the truly unique Motorcycle Experience World at Top Mountain Crosspoint in Hochgurgl.

Gurgl is a fabulous summer retreat that enchants people of all ages thanks to its high alpine location and varied nature, adventures and sporty activities. The altitude of over 2,000 fm ensures a pleasant climate even on hot days. Therefore it also allows for an enjoyable break as well as healthy sports and activities or (natural) wellness. Among the latest highlights ranks forest bathing along the local theme trail on Ochsenkopf. This lovely route invites you to experience the calming atmosphere of the forest intensively. Along the walking path, visitors will find wooden bathtubs, lounger nets and a tree house just perfect to pause. The route also offers wonderful viewpoints and information panels. Thanks to comfy summer mountain

lifts, nature enthusiasts can easily and comfortably access the extensive hiking network comprising highaltitude huts or loop hiking tours. A popular viewing platform can be found at Kirchenkar Gondola (2,839 h), visitors also enjoy an excursion to Hohe Mut Alm including panoramic views of myriad three thousand meter high peaks. Those who conquer the scenic Hohe Mut via ferrata - one of the easier of its kind in Ötztal – can indulge in the unique panorama. The uppermost part of Ötztal also makes a paradise for mountain fans on two wheels. Road cyclists tackle the stage up to Timmelsjoch. For (e)bikers, a tour to Langtalereckhütte or Lenzenalm is worthwhile - here hearty delicacies provide fresh energy for the return.



WHERE PROFESSIONALS DO THEIR TRAINING UNITS

The Diamond of the Alps is a popular training location for top athletes, and not just in winter. One of the prominent summer guests is the former ski mountaineer and current professional cyclist Toni Palzer. The athlete of the professional Red Bull – BORA – hansgrohe cycling team uses the quiet surroundings and the ideal altitude to specifically increase his stamina and performance. Timmelsjoch Pass in particular - its challenging climbs, the alpine landscape and the varied routes - offer Palzer and his teammates ideal conditions for intensive training sessions. In the 2024 summer, he spent three weeks in Gurgl. "I'm a real mountain person and a huge fan of Gurgl. Here I have few distractions and can complete



my training program in an undisturbed manner. This preparation phase is an integral part of modern cycling," states the native Bavarian. He appreciates the huge variety of options: "In addition to the peace and quiet, Ötztal is an ideal training ground for me as a mountain cyclist. I can find the perfect route for all requirements."



HIGHEST PASS CROSSING POINT OF THE EASTERN ALPS

A visit to Top Mountain Crosspoint that houses the Motorcycle Experience World, Europe's highest motorbike museum at the foot of the Timmelsjoch High Alpine Road, is an absolute must-see. More than 550 historic motorcycles and sports cars make the hearts of technology and vintage fans beat faster, while interactive stations offer exciting insights and hands-on experiences. Among the special highlights are the 4D cinema and marvelous special exhibitions showing new attractions every year. The panoramic Timmelsjoch High Alpine Road boasts unique driving experiences and connects North and South Tyrol. By car, motorcycle or road bicycle, you can climb the highest mountain pass of the Eastern Alps at 2,500 fm while enjoying picture-book alpine views. Several rest stop areas along the route provide information about the region's specific culture and nature and invite you to linger a while.
